



WALK-IN/REFRIGERATION WARRANTIES

15 YEAR ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT PANEL WARRANTY – MASTER-BILT FOAM WALK-IN ROOM PANELS

WARRANTY COVERAGE: This warranty neither assumes, nor authorizes any person to assume, any obligation other than that covered by this warranty, and applies only within the continental boundaries of the United States of America, its territories and possessions, and Canada.

Master-Bilt warrants this product to be free from defects in material or workmanship under normal use and service. In the event of failure, the obligation of Master-Bilt under this warranty shall be limited to repairing or replacing with a like panel, at Master-Bilt's option, F.O.B. Hudson, WI, any original equipment panel of the warranted original equipment product which proves defective, and which Master-Bilt's examination shall disclose to its satisfaction to be thus defective, and which cannot be placed back into operation in the field with normal service efforts.

Master-Bilt warrants this product to be free from defects in material or workmanship under normal use and service. In the event of failure, the obligation of Master-Bilt under this warranty shall be limited to replacement materials.

A replacement panel installed as a result of this warranty is not subsequently covered by this warranty. Master-Bilt reserves the right to require the return, collect freight, of any defective panel. **A Master-Bilt provided authorization number is required before the return of any panel.**

The warranty is in force for fifteen (15) years from date of installation, but not longer than fifteen (15) years, three (3) months from Master-Bilt invoice date. Any claim for defects occurring between fifteen (15) years and fifteen (15) years, three (3) months from Master-Bilt invoice date must furnish proof that installation date did occur within three (3) months of Master-Bilt invoice date.

WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS: Master-Bilt's obligation on non-Master-Bilt manufactured items shall be limited only to the extent of the warranty extended by the respective manufacturers of said products. This warranty does not apply to the panel finish. Floor panels are not warranted under the following conditions: wet mopping or use of a water hose for cleaning, rolling wheel traffic (carts, dollies, etc) on non-reinforced (overlay) floors and/or weight loads exceeding 800 lbs/sq.ft on non-structural floors.
